

# Parish Leader Action Plan

The Parish Leader action plan is for Youth ministers and Parish leaders who want a proven and simple process for connecting students to the Catholic faith in college!

#### 1. How To Collect Names:

The easiest way to collect your student names & contact information is at a gathering of some sort. That can be a "Senior Night," senior dinner/reception thrown by the parish, or Graduation Mass. You can use something as simple as a clipboard with a sheet of paper OR use our free student sign-up cards.

Take a minute to have each student sign up one of two ways:

- Use our <u>sign-up link</u> to enter them individually.
- Create a Google sheet or Excel spreadsheet and email it to us at ccamptom@ newmanministry.com.

### 2. Sign-up Station:

Another easy way to connect your student is having a year-long sign-up station. A great location for this is in the Vestibule or Narthex. Simply place a signup sheet or student sign-up cards and collect them after every weekend of masses. To increase the likelihood of parents and other parishioners knowing about the sign-up station, you can announce the end of each Mass or run week-after-week bulletin ads.

### 3. Place Sign-up Cards in Pews:

Be sure to place either our student sign-up cards or your own in each pew to be grabbed and filled out. Some Priests will allow student contact cards to be filled out after the homily & collected at the end of Mass. If this is your chosen route, be sure to communicate with your Pastor about the logistics.

### 4. Collect Names All Year:

Our biggest encouragement is to collect names all year! A simple way to do this is to keep a Google sheet or Excel spreadsheet on your desktop (especially if you're the Youth minister).

When you can invite your seniors to get connected, simply fill out the spreadsheet and send it in at the end of the year. **The Parish Leader action plan (see here)** is for Youth ministers and Parish leaders who want a proven and simple process for connecting students to the Catholic faith in college!

### 5. If You Don't Have a Youth Minister:

In Parishes that do not have a Youth Minister, your secretary or DRE can go to the church directory & see who has been confirmed to figure out whom they need to contact as a Graduating Senior. From there, you can send out an email or call the parents to discuss getting them connected after graduation.
